The Device Internet

- ➤ Thermostats (Nest Labs purchased by Google for \$3.2b)

Rule 2: If you're using a free service or program, you're sharing information with someone.


Rule 3: Forget Big Brother. It's the Little Cousins.



Ransomware

- Finally the bad guys have a business model that works
- Cryptolocker has no solution once infected
- Patching is now as important as AV software





More and more interaction (including \$) on mobile platforms means companies will have to either standardize (risk of losing customers) or have multiple web platforms (increased cost or decreased functionality). Simple SIT Vision, Confidence of Marketing Strategy for Business IT

Storage, More, more, more

Significant increases in flexibility, complexity, synchronizing options, sharing options, etc, etc.

Desktops and Laptops

The importance of Desktops and Laptops will decrease significantly relative to both business and individual IT needs, being replaced by mobile devices.
